Why: To provide school districts with the ability to create and refine effective EL programs that meet Lau Plan Requirements. This SDDOE-approved program gives teachers the credentials to be “highly-qualified” ESL teachers (with the ENL endorsement) and also gives classroom teachers the tools needed to work with Language Learners in the content classroom.

Format: Each course delivered in a hybrid format , Twelve-week sessions (tentative), set up in 2-week modules

Cost: \$70 per credit for State-Wide Title III & Migrant Consortium Members, plus text books

FROM SD DOE:

The endorsement for the South Dakota Teaching Certificate requires 18 credits.

The remaining 6 credits can be selected from the following:

Any Foreign Language or ESL course, Linguistics course, literacy methods courses, cultural education, ESL, etc

Since the ENL endorsement is K-12, those who have only a 7-12 or Elementary certificate will also need to have a one credit ESL internship at the missing level. This internship will be embedded within the course-work, with the 1-credit registration being in the final semester of the program.
